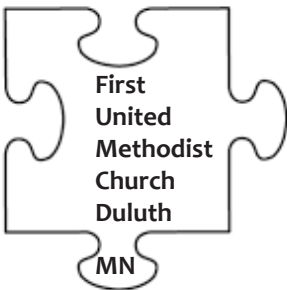

## Worship Force

- Gatherers: Trained pairs of adult & student (minimum third grade) collect Sunday offering during worship, gather recyclable materials and straighten worship materials after worship

- Acolytes: Trained candle lighters and extinguishers (minimum fourth grade)

- Wee Wonder Teen Team: Trained teen leaders aid adult leaders in the Wee Wonder ministry (minimum sixth grade)

- Projection Team: Trained teen leaders (minimum sixth grade) use computer projection system to display song lyrics, prayers and worship aids during worship



# Work & Service

## Outreach

**Ruby's Pantry:** Volunteers are needed each month to help at Ruby's Pantry, our food distribution ministry held on the third Thursday of the month. Choose from registration/welcome, unloading truck, traffic control, bulk food repackaging, food distribution, carry-out, box recycling, clean-up and other tasks. This event runs from 3 pm unloading time to 8 pm clean up. Come and go as you have time; even an hour of help is appreciated.

## In the Kitchen

**Wednesday Night Meals:** During the school year, FUMC volunteers prepare, serve and clean up a simple weekly supper for all comers. Small groups within the church take turns in the kitchen providing a meal for the musicians, students, families, and individuals participating in Wednesday Night Ministries. Get some friends together and sign up in the church office for the Wednesday of your choice. Menu suggestions and recipes available.



**Roast Beef Dinners:** Spring and fall, we all pitch in to make and serve as as many as 700 roast beef dinners, complete with homemade apple pie. There's even a drive-through! This is a fundraiser for the work of the church, and it's also one big ol' work party for 130 or so volunteers over three days. Our spring Roast Beef Dinner will be April 27. You can sign up to help or buy tickets Sundays before and after church.

**Rhubarb:** In about six work days each June, FUMC makes hundreds of pies plus scones and candy for the CHUM Rhubarb Festival. Watch for announcements of work days.

# Care Ministries

## **Prayer Shawl Ministry**

Prayer shawls wrap, enfold, surround, and comfort the recipients as a tangible symbol of love and care. Stitchers meet on the second Wednesday of each month at 9:30am in the Fireside Lounge. Newcomers are always welcome.



## **Prayer Chain**

Prayer Chain prays as requested for church members, their families, and others who seek God's healing and understanding love. Ask in the office to join the team or request a prayer.

## **Prayer Team**

FUMC's Prayer Team prays daily for the work of our church in this community, as well as the wider Church throughout the world. Each Sunday morning at 9:50am the team meets for five minutes in the Three Brothers Chapel to pray for the worship service and all in attendance each week. You are most welcome to join in prayer on any Sunday.

Care Team visits and shares the comfort of the Christian faith with those in homes, nursing centers, and hospitals through listening, talking, and praying. The Congregational Care ministry also provides meals at times of emergencies and loss.
