Purpose of Scholarship

Expectations

Sing at weekly Wednesday evening rehearsals from 5:45-6:45pm

As much as possible, sing at special services with the choir such as the Duluth's Community Interfaith Thanksgiving service, Christmas Eve service, and Holy Week services.

Faithfully attend and be punctual to all rehearsals, worship services, and performances. We know that you may be absent during breaks in the academic year and we will plan accordingly. Other excused absences include college ensemble events, such as a dress rehearsal or concert.

Opportunities

Opportunities exist for leading sectional rehearsals, conducting selected anthems, leading warm-ups, and singing vocal solos depending upon the Choral Scholar's interest and abilities.

Honorarium

The Choral Scholar will receive an honorarium of \$100 per month paid at the end of each month.

Application

Through an application process, the First UMC Choral Scholar Program will give priority to college students majoring in music. The individual will be selected by Mike Goodlet, First UMC's Choir Director, and Velda Bell, First UMC's Music Director/Organist.
